The quiet, residential Georgian Montpellier area of Cheltenham may not be the first place you'd think of for locating a down-to-earth pub, especially one tucked away on a corner, but it's worth going that extra mile to check out the Beehive. Though expanded, its original cosy green and frosted glass façade is still present. Not a lot has changed inside, either: rough wooden floorboards, a bar and various settles, benches and large wood tables, along with a wood burner and even a slot machine, give it a genuine unaffected 'proper' pub feel. There's a separate snug, above which is a former Masonic lodge hall, where more dining tables are set. Locally renowned, the cooking here is good and honest, not really traditional pub fare, but in the up-to-date restaurant league.
